In our hands-on workshops, you will



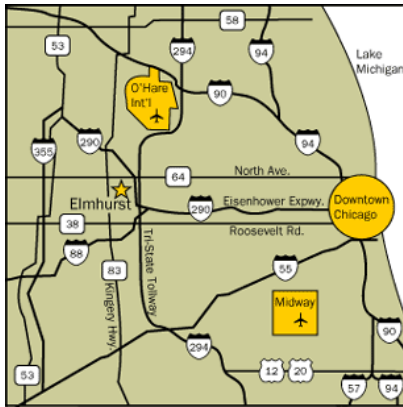
- Learn practical strategies for using cutting edge technology to enhance and extend your curriculum, improve student achievement and increase the effectiveness and efficiency of your use of technology;
